Intention For Use

Thank you for purchasing this mains operated (240V AC) orbital car polisher from Streetwize. This polisher is intended for polishing your vehicle after you have washed, cleaned and wiped your vehicle to help you achieve that professional showroom shine.

It is suitable for use on vehicles with both metallic and non-metallic paintwork.

This car polisher is also suitable for polishing tiled floors & walls as well as polished wooden surfaces (i.e. furniture and floors).

Before using this product, please read through all the information in this document. Please keep it for future reference.

Health & Safety Guidelines

1. WORK AREA

- Keep your work area clean and well lit. Cluttered and dark areas can potentially cause accidents.
- Keep children and bystanders away while operating a power tool.

2. ELECTRICAL SAFETY

- Never modify the plug in any way. Modified plugs risk electric shock.
- Do not use any adaptor plugs with this product.
- Avoid body contact with earthed or grounded surfaces such as pipes, radiators, ranges and refrigerators. Risk of electric shock.
- Do not expose this product to rain or wet conditions. Water entering this product will increase the risk of electric shock.
- Never use the power cord for carrying, pulling or unplugging the power tool. Please keep the power cord away from heat, oil, sharp edges or moving parts. Damaged or entangled cords increase the risk of electric shock.
- When operating this product outdoors, use an extension cord suitable for outdoor use.

3. PERSONAL SAFETY

- Do not use a power tool while you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication.
- Please wear the appropriate safety equipment when operating this equipment. We advise you to wear safety gloves, safety shoes and protective eyewear.
- Don't wear loose clothing or jewellery.
- Always ensure the switch is set to the off position when connecting to your mains socket.
- Do not overreach. Keep proper footing and balance at all times when using this product. This enables better control of the power tool in unexpected situations.

4. POWER TOOL USE AND CARE

- Do not exert too much pressure when polishing. Simply allow the polishing machine to glide over the polishing surface.
- Do not use the product if the switch does not turn on or off. Please get it repaired by a qualified professional.

Product Elements

- Streetwize 10" Orbital Car Polisher
- 1 x textile polishing pad
- 1 x fine polishing pad
- 1 x polishing applicator (paste)

Instructions for use

IMPORTANT: Prior to polishing a surface, make sure that the surface is fully washed, clean and wiped. Also, please ensure that both polishing pads (both textile & fine polishing pads) are clean and free from any dirt or grit.

- 1. Pull the textile polishing cap over the polishing pad. The pads are designed to fit tightly, it is essential that time is taken to fit the pad correctly.
- 2. Apply the polishing paste over the polishing pad. Do not apply the polish paste directly to the surface you are polishing.
- 3. Hold the polisher with both hands via the twin handle, position it on the surface, and then switch on.

IMPORTANT: Only turn on the car polisher when the polisher is resting on the surface. Never turn on the polisher when lifted. Risk of injury.

4. Place the extension lead over your shoulder and work first on the large, flat surfaces such as the bonnet, boot lid and roof. Keep your movements as regular as possible.

TIP: Allow the polishing machine to glide over the surface you are polishing. Do not exert pressure.

- 5. Work next on the smaller surfaces (doors, for example). Allow the mains cable to hang from the appliance and hold the polishing machine as illustrated below
- 6. For less accessible areas (such as wing-mirrors, bumpers and door handles etc) remove the polishing cap from the pad and polish these areas by hand.
- 7. Now replace the textile polishing cap with the fine polishing cap and pull this over the polishing pad. Repeat as above for a professional finish.



Maintenance Guidelines

- Both polishing pads are NOT machine washable. Please hand wash with a mild soap after each use and allow to hang dry.
- When not in use, remove the polishing cap and store the polishing machine upside down so that the polishing pad can dry and retain its original shape.
- The excessive use of wax and paste can cause the polishing cap to jump off the polishing pad while polishing. **IMPORTANT:** Do NOT use abrasive polishing agents

Looking After Your Vehicle - Care Tips

- For optimum paintwork protection, you should polish your car 2 to 3 times per year.
- Wash your car at least every 2 weeks. Avoid using household detergents as these can damage the paintwork and remove the layer of wax.
- Wash your car with a clean sponge, working from top to bottom.
- Remove all insects, bird droppings and tar stains from the paintwork daily.
- If you use any window-cleaning agents, spray them onto a cloth and not directly onto the windows in order to prevent the cleaning agent getting onto the paintwork.
